As we walk down Grapevine's Public Art Trail – experience a series of highly visibly public bronze sculptures located throughout town. Stroll through the quaint boutiques and antique shops and pick up a memento of your visit!

Stop by the popular, open-air weekend Grapevine Market where you can find the finest handmade jewelry, distinctive home décor and quality antiques. Before you leave be sure to try Grapevine Market's famous sweet potatoes pies and bread pudding!
