- The biggest improvement to the Rover Setup for the $2^{\text {nd }}$ Weekend was the replacement of the feed-line between the transverter and dish. The old test equipment cable measured roughly 3.6 dB of loss compared the new cable 10 foot of FSJ-2 $3 / 8$ " super-flex which has a specified loss on 1.6 dB .
