


Second Annual Gulf of Mexico 10 GHz and Above Contest




Objectives

Plans Change


Primary plan was to operate from Burns

coast.


Work Texas stations on Saturday, east Gulf coast on Sunday from Grand Isle.

Louisiana to Texas Path






Potential Dilemma



Burns Point Park is 136 miles from Grand Isle. Working rovers from Texas to Florida could present a problem. More investigation needed.


Grand Isle Grid Squares



Island is 7 miles long




Two Operating LocationsWithin EL49xf





Why Move Operating Locations




Grand Isle is positioned in a northeast/southwest direction. The northeast points to Mobile, AL.

Saturday's Location in EL49xf






Sunday Morning still in EL49xf








Motel manager lets me use the deck for the day.


Dawn contact with K4QF







Most of the day, WA8RJF was across the neighbors deck.




WA8RJF Roving Sunday

Chasing the shadows to keep the equipment cool.



All signals were 59+, ssb mode. CW was used to initiate a few skeds.


My signal heard 781 km/ 485 mi away.
